



**Chuck Reed, Mayor
City of San José
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Chuck Reed was appointed by the City of San Jose to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The area of North San Jose and Alviso receive water from the San Francisco regional water system. This service area is predominantly industrial with some residential and commercial land use.

Prior to being elected a Mayor in November 2006, Mayor Reed served as councilmember for District 4, representing over 96,000 residents in the Alviso, Berryessa and North San Jose areas. District 4 includes more than 2,500 Silicon Valley businesses in the Innovation Triangle area of North San Jose.

Reed was elected to the city council in November 2000. He sits on the council's Driving a Strong Economy Committee and Making Government Work Better Committee. Reed serves on several other city boards and commissions. He represents the City of San José on the Santa Clara County Recycling and Waste Reduction Commission and the San Jose Convention and Visitors Bureau.

Prior to being elected to the San Jose City Council, Reed was chair of the Santa Clara County Planning Commission, chair of the San Jose/Silicon Valley Chamber of Commerce, president of the San Jose Downtown Association, and chair of the San Jose Planning Commission.

Reed has been an attorney in private practice in San Jose since 1978, specializing in environmental, employment, land use and real estate law, and commercial litigation. He is a graduate of the United States Air Force Academy, Princeton University and Stanford University. He served in the U.S. Air Force and was stationed in Thailand during the Vietnam War. Reed has been married to Paula Reed for over 30 years. They have two children, Alex Reed, who is a student at Santa Clara University, and Kim Campbell, who is an Air Force fighter pilot.
