



**Robert C. Craig, EdD, LLD**

Robert Charles Craig, EdD, LLD was appointed by the Westborough Water District to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The district provides water to a population of nearly 10,000 residents within the City of South San Francisco. The district provides both water and sewer service and has an agreement with the North San Mateo County Sanitation District for sewage disposal and facility maintenance.

Dr. Craig joined the board of the Westborough Water District in 1982 and has served four terms as President. He has been an alternate commissioner on the Local Agency Formation Commission since 2000. Dr. Craig also is a commissioner on the Association of California Water Agencies-JPIA.

He is a Professor Emeritus in Design and Industry for San Francisco State University (SFSU), having served the university as a professor from 1965 to 1994. He also served the university as Director of the Center for Technological Education, Chairman of the Department of Design and Industry, and Director of the Creative Arts Computing Center.

Prior to joining SFSU, Dr. Craig held industrial positions with Lawrence Radiation Laboratory, Shell Development and Development Engineers, Inc. He holds a doctorate in Education from the University of Southern California, a master's degree from San Francisco State University and a bachelor's degree from the University of California, Santa Barbara. He was awarded an honorary Law and Letters degree from Southern University. Dr. Craig also completed graduate studies in nuclear physics at the University of California, Los Angeles.

He was a radar specialist with the U.S. Navy and First Lieutenant in a heavy weapons company with the U.S. Army. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary for 15 years as a flotilla commander, district staff officer and Coast Guard sea marshal.

Dr. Craig served on the State of California Professional Standards Commission and has consulted to five California state legislators, as well as Krames Communications Publishing. Dr. Craig also has served as an expert witness for several law firms.
