



**Rosalie O'Mahony, Council Member
City of Burlingame
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Rosalie O'Mahony was appointed by the City of Burlingame to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency. The city's water system serves the entire area within its city limits, plus portions of unincorporated Burlingame Hills and a few properties in San Mateo and Hillsborough.

O'Mahony is Chair of the BAWSCA board of directors. She served as Chair of the Board Policy Committee from 2004 to 2006. Ms. O'Mahony was first elected to the city council in 1989. Currently the city's Vice Mayor, she served as Mayor in 1994, 1997, 2000, and 2004. Ms. O'Mahony is a Professor of Mathematics at the College of San Mateo where she has been teaching since 1965. She holds a Ph.D. from the University of Southern California.

In community service, she has served as city chair of the American Cancer Society, and as a board member of the Easter Seal Society and the Suicide Prevention and Crisis Center. She was a member of the 1986 County Grand Jury, where she served as secretary and chair of the budget and fiscal committee. She is a past member of the Burlingame Newcomers Club, the Irish Literary and Historical Society, and the Burlingame Historical Society, on which she served as secretary. She also has served on the San Mateo County Transportation Authority Citizens' Advisory Committee and the Burlingame Beautification Commission, which she chaired.

Vice Mayor O'Mahony represented the city on the Airport Roundtable and on the County Emergency Services Committees from 1990 through 1994. She was budget chair for the city from 1995 through 2000.

She currently serves on the city audit committee. She reviews warrants and is interim chair of the San Mateo County Investment Advisory Council. O'Mahony also represents the city on the City and County Association of Governments (C/CAG). She served as C/CAG vice-chair from 1996 to 1998 and as chair from 1998 to 2000. O'Mahony is vice-chair of San Mateo County Transit Authority.
