



**Armando Gomez, Council Member
City of Milpitas
Board of Directors
Bay Area Water Supply & Conservation Agency**

Armando Gomez was appointed by the City of Milpitas to the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency in May 2009. The City is divided into two service areas, with the northeast area supplied with water from the San Francisco regional water system and the remaining areas served by the Santa Clara Valley Water District.

Gomez was elected to the City Council in November 2002 and was re-elected in November 2006 and November 2010. He currently serves as Chair of the Transportation and Land Use Subcommittee and as a member Rules Subcommittee, and is the Council Liaison on the Community Advisory Commission, and Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Commission. He is a member of the League of California Cities Peninsula Division, and the Santa Clara Valley Water District Policy Advisory Committee.

Gomez also currently serves as the Mayor's Budget Director for the City of San Jose. A position he was appointed to in November 2006. Prior to his current professional work, he served Chief of Staff for then Councilmember Chuck Reed, as Budget and Legislative Analyst for the San Francisco Board of Supervisor's Budget Analyst's Office, and was a Special Assistant to the Ethics Commission.

Gomez is a resident of Milpitas for more than 35 years and a graduate of Milpitas High School. He earned his Bachelors of Science in Political Science from Santa Clara University.
