## **Directions to Foster City Library/Community Bldg.**

1000 E. Hillsdale Blvd., Foster City
The Library/Community Bldg. is on the SE corner of Hillsdale and Shell Blvd.

<u>From Hwy. 101 North</u>, take the Hillsdale Ave. exit East. Turn Right into the parking lot just after the intersection with Shell Blvd. <u>The Community Bldg. entrance is separate from the Library entrance and is marked by signage. The Wind Room will be at the top of the stairs on the right, across from the reception station (there is also an elevator).</u>

From Hwy. 101 South, take 92 East, exiting at Foster City Blvd., preparing to turn Right (West) onto Metro Centre Blvd. at the traffic signal. Get in left-hand lane on Metro Centre to make a Left turn onto Shell Blvd. at next traffic signal (Costco will be on right). Proceed South on Shell Blvd. to Hillsdale, turning East onto Hillsdale and then South into parking lot for Library/Community Bldg. See underlined sentence in first paragraph above for remainder of directions. (Alternatively, take Hillsdale Ave., Eastbound, following same directions as from Hwy. 101 North. Taking 92, etc., eliminates what is usually a bottleneck on 101 southbound around Ralston)

<u>From the East Bay</u>, take Hwy. 92 West, exiting at Foster City Blvd., and going South on Foster City Blvd. to Hillsdale. Turn Right (West) onto Hillsdale and proceed to Shell Blvd., making a Uturn to be able to pull into parking lot on SE corner of Hillsdale and Shell. See underlined sentence of first paragraph above for remainder of directions.
