#### Directions to Foster City Community Bldg. - 1000 E. Hillsdale Blvd., Foster City

<u>From Hwy. 101</u>, take the Hillsdale Ave. exit East. Turn Right into the parking lot just after the intersection with Shell Blvd. <u>The Community Bldg. entrance is separate from the Library entrance and is marked by signage.</u> <u>The Wind Room will be at the top of the stairs on the right, across from the reception station (there is also an elevator).</u>
