Summary:



Discussion:

The suggested process for electing the chair is as follows:

- 1. Call for nominations for the position of chairperson.
- 2. Call for a motion to close nominations once no further names are offered.
- 3. If there is only one nominee, call for the vote.
- 4. If there is more than one nominee, then proceeding alphabetically:
 - a. Ask each nominee to give a brief statement on his/her qualifications and interest in the position.
 - b. Ask if other directors would like to comment on behalf of the nominee.
 - c. Call for a vote of those in favor of each nominee, by a show of hands.

Following the election of the chair, proceed to the election of vice chair using the same process.



Agenda Title: Adoption of the FY 2019-20 Budget for the San Francisco Bay Area

Regional Water System Financing Authority

Summary:

The BAWSCA Board of Directors adopted its FY 2019-20 budget on May 17, 2019. That budget contains an budget allowance to cover the few operating expenses that are anticipated to be incurred by the San Francisco Bay Area Regional Water System Financing Authority (RFA). The California Water Code requires the RFA Board of Directors to adopt a budget for each fiscal year (Division 31.7, Section 81650). While the BAWSCA Board adopted the BAWSCA FY 2019-20 budget, which included the RFA budget allowance, January 16, 2020 is the only RFA meeting in FY 2019-20 and is therefore, the RFA budget adoption action is scheduled accordingly.

As of November 30, 2019, the RFA expenses for FY 2019-20 are \$2,309, or 140% of the RFA budget allowance adopted by the BAWSCA Board in May 2019, due to unforeseen expenses related to director appointments. As this overbudget expense is a small amount of money that can be readily accommodated within BAWSCA's overall FY 2019-20 budget and the contract for legal counsel expenses approved by the Board in May 2019, no change to the RFA budget allowance is proposed as part of this recommended action.

Fiscal Impact:

The adopted FY 2019-20 BAWSCA budget of \$4,569,750 includes the budgeted allowance of \$1,650 for RFA expenses to cover anticipated director attendance fees, legal expenses, insurance and other costs.

Table A. Budget Summary by Major Expenditure Category

The RFA budget for FY 2018-19 was \$1,650. Total expenses for the RFA in FY 2018-19 were \$462, or 28% of budget. The proposed FY 2019-20 RFA budget remains the same at \$1,650.

Recommendation:

That the RFA Board adopt the proposed FY 2019-20 budget for the RFA totaling \$1,650.
